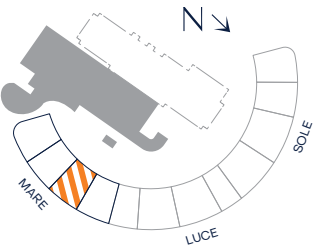

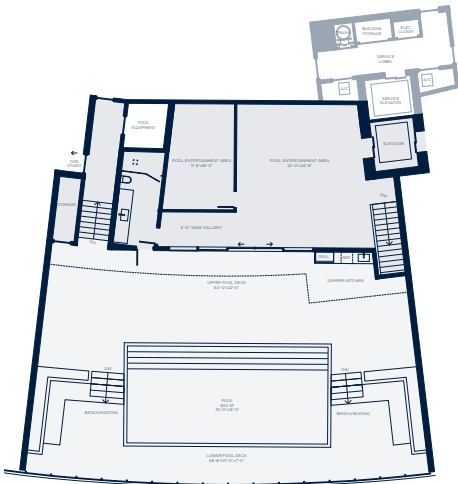

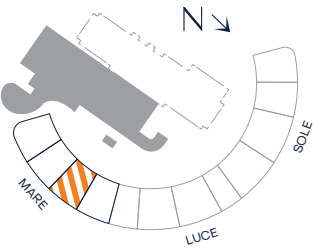

ACCORDINGLY, THE AREA OF THE ACTUAL ROOM WILL TYPICALLY BE SMALLER THAN THE PRODUCT OBTAINED BY MULTIPLYING THE STATED LENGTH TIMES WIDTH. ALL DIMENSIONS ARE APPROXIMATE AND MAY VARY WITH ACTUAL CONSTRUCTION, AND ALL FLOOR PLANS AND DEVELOPMENT PLANS ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE. 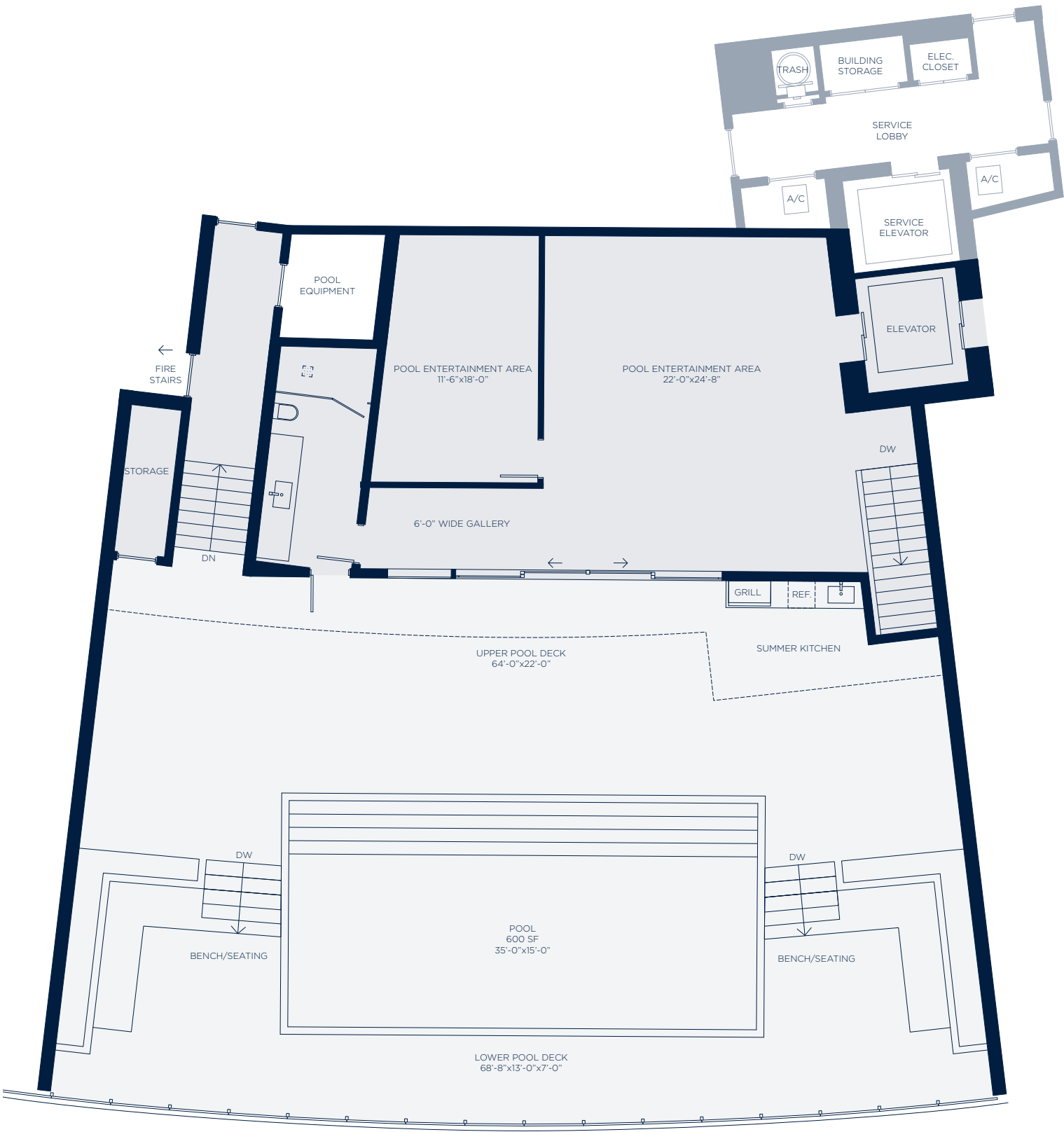
